We are thrilled to offer this eight-week land-based adventure program in our new Forest Walk at The Jungle Farm! Geared towards youth ages 11-16, participants will learn about wild foods and wild crafting, medicinal flowers, composting, importance of supporting insects and modern preservation methods. As part of the Indigenous learning that stems naturally from the Forest Walk, there will also be time for reflection of our place on the land.

At The Jungle Farm, we are committed to growing the highest quality, fresh produce along with fun family activities and education. Our farm has been in our family for over 125 years and we are happy to be able to share our farm with your family.

Our new Nature School pilot program was created by horticulturist Katie Prokopchuk, who is a member of Beaver First Nations. Katie worked for with us at The Jungle Farm for three summers while attending Olds College! This program is geared to ages 11-16. The program will be 8 Thursdays this summer. Each week will be a two hour themed program. **The program runs from 10:00 am till noon on Thursdays starting July 9, 2026.**

We will have experienced staff working with your children to make this an interactive, educational farm experience. You are welcome to join your children on the program or send them off to enjoy the time on their own. We do have a first aider with them at all times.

Our program **runs rain or shine** so come dressed for the weather. The program will be OUTSIDE, so extra clothes for weather is recommended.

Registration and pricing information is on the second page - registration is on a first come, first served basis. This program is only offered one day this year. Once it is full, we will create a waiting list. Registration is only complete when the application form and payment have been received at The Jungle Farm. You will receive a confirmation email.
